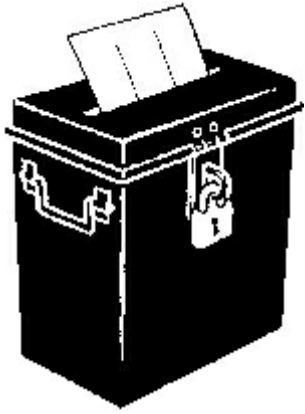

ELECTIONS NOMINATIONS FORM



Elections will take place following the Regional Conference for the North West Liberal Democrats executive for 2025.

The executive is made up of 42 members of the party from across the region, elected annually to lead the organisation, along with a President elected every two years, Parliamentarians representing the region, a representative from Liberal Youth, and up to five co-opted members.

The executive comprises:

- President - Chair - Treasurer - Secretary
- 6 Vice Chairs, who lead the sub-committees: Campaigns, Candidates, Conferences, Membership Diversity & Inclusion, Policy, Standards & Practice.
- Up to 32 Ordinary members with county places reserved to ensure geographic balance

The Executive meets 4-5 times a year, normally on Saturdays. During the pandemic this moved online; previously it met at venues around the region. In 2024 it has been a mix of both.

Executive members are involved in subcommittees, and Officers (Chair, Treasurer, Secretary, Vice Chairs) have additional responsibilities. Elections will also be held to elect a number of regional representatives to the party's English Council. The regional chair is also a representative, ex-officio. There will also be the election of four members of the Regional Candidates Committee.

Nominations must be submitted by the close of the conference.

They must be in writing and nominations must be proposed and seconded for any position with signatures to show support of nomination. Election artwork is invited in support of candidacy: Timetables and specifications will be sent to those in contested elections.

Nominations should be submitted to the Returning Officer, Bob Charlesworth - for details see right.

Nomination forms must be submitted by the close of Regional Conference in Stockport, Saturday 12 October 2023.

The new executive will take office from 1st January 2025.
